\$600,000 Damage Suit Filed
Against Wallace's Assassin

UPPER MARLBORO, Md., Feb.
18 (AP)—A \$600,000 damage
suit has been filed in the Upper
Marlboro Circuit Court against
Arthur H. Bremer, who was
convicted of shooting Gov.
George C. Wallace of Alabama
at a shopping center in Laurel,
Md., last may 15.

The suit was filed by Dora

Thompson, one of four persons
wounded in the shooting.

Harold F. Golding, attorney
for Mrs. Thompson, said she
expects to collect damages from
royalties Bremer is expected to
receive from publication of his
diary.

Mr. Golding is asking \$300,000 in punitive damages in the
civil case, and \$200,000 for Mrs.
Thompson's injuries. An additional \$100,000 is being sought
for loss of companionship.
