

## Wallace Leaves Hospital

Montgomery, Ala.

Alabama Governor George C. Wallace returned home yesterday after four weeks in the hospital for an operation which he described as a complete success.

"I'm feeling fine. It's good to be back," Wallace told newsmen at the airport in Montgomery. "I should have had it done before. I feel good."

The governor underwent surgery January 26 in a Birmingham hospital to aid his bladder drainage. It was his sixth operation since he was wounded and left paralyzed in both legs in an assassination attempt last May 15.

A hospital official in Birmingham quoted Wallace's doctors as saying he is in satisfactory condition and that they are pleased with his progress.

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
