Bremer's Brother in **Guilty Plea**

Miami

William Bremer, whose brother was convicted of the attempted assassination of Governor George C. Wallace of Alabama, has pleaded guilty to 178 counts of fraud involving the operation of a weightreducing salon.

In return for Bremer's guilty plea Tuesday before Circuit Judge Edward Cowart, the prosecution agreed to drop 77 additional counts list him and 202 counts against his wife, Earl.

Bremer faces a maximum prison term of 49 years and fines totaling \$102,500.

He was arrested after hundreds of women who had bought memberships called police in March 1972 to complain that the doors were locked at Bremer's three Fraire Form Reducing Stu-

do eitlets and all the exercise equipment had been removed.

Bremer wounger brother, Arthur, was convicted of the May, 1972, all empted assassination of the Alabama governor.
