

Arthur Bremer Denied Retrial By Appeal Court

Annapolis, Md.

The Maryland special court of appeals refused yesterday to grant a new trial to Arthur H. Bremer, the former Milwaukee dishwasher convicted of shooting Alabama Governor George C. Wallace last year.

In a unanimous decision, the court denied Bremer's contention that his constitutional rights were violated because of pre-trial publicity, which he said made it impossible for him to receive a fair trial.

Bremer is serving 53 years in the Maryland penitentiary for shooting Wallace during a political rally May 15, 1972, at a Laurel, Md., shopping center.
