Wallace May Run Again In '76

Albertville, Ala.

Alabama Governor George Wallace, currently seeking his third term as governor, says he will run for president in 1976 if his supporters ask him to make the race.

Speaking from a flatbed truck at a shopping center Saturday night, Wallace said he would make his fourth presidential campain despite the attempt on his life the last time he ran for president.

Wallace was shot and paralyzed from the waist down during the 1972 Maryland Democratic presidential primary, which he won the day after he was shot.

"I'll run for the presidency in 1976 if they want me to run, whether my critics like it or not," Wallace said.

"If I think it will help Alabama and the country — that will be the main thing." he said. "When I was shot in the last primary I had more votes than anybody."
