Wallace Won't Go to Maryland

Montgomery, Ala.

Governor George C. Wallace yesterday canceled a trip to Laurel, Md., that had been scheduled for Saturday, the fourth anniversary of the shooting at a Laurel shopping center that left Wallace crippled.

The trip was announced Friday by Wallace's campaign office, but Billy Joe Camp, Wallace's press secretary, said yesterday that Wallace had never approved the trip.

Camp said "it is not anticipated" that Wallace will do any campaigning in Maryland before the primary May 18. He won the 1972 primary, which was held the day after Arthur Bremer shot him.

Camp said he did not know if the Secret Service had recommended against the trip. The shooting left Wallace paralyzed from the waist down and forced him to abandon his 1972 campaign.
