A Warren Critic Asks New Probe

Edward Jay Epstein, au-thor of the book "Inquest: thor of the book "Inquest: The Warren Commission and the Establishmen tof Truth," told some 200 Uni-versity of California stu-dents yesterday that the Warren Commission "con-ducted a superficial inves-tigation" into the death of President Kennedy. He called on the .govern-ment to establish i m m e di-ately panels of experts to

ately panels of experts to re-examine the evidence.

He said that if the "single bullet" theory were aban-doned "all the rest of the facts will fall down like a house of cards."

He said the commission was under severe deadline pressure and that most of the investigating was done by junior lawyers, the senior lawyers and the commission members being tee busy to members being too busy to conduct a thorough investigation.

Although the public has much information on such things as the killing of Of-ficer Tippett, he said, "we know virtually nothing about the assassination of the President himself."
