KUPFERMAN TO JOIN LAW FIRM IN APRIL

Representative Theodore R. Kupferman will join the law firm of Battle, Fowler, Stokes & Kheel as counsel on April 1.

The new association for Mr. Kupferman, who has maintained his own law firm in the city since 1958, led to immediate speculation as to whether he would continue to represent Manhattan's 17th (Silk Stocking) District in the Congress when his present term ends Dec. 31, 1968.

Reached by telephone in Washington, Mr. Kupferman, who is 40 years old, said he intended to remain active in politics and had no intention of relinquishing his House seat.

As counsel to the Battle firm, he will be consulted on all phases of litigation, particularly in the field of appeals involving the entertainment industry.
