How Ted sees JFK probe

Keene, N.H. - Sen. Edward Kennedy says the investigation into the assassination of President John F. Kennedy should be reopened only if there is sufficient evidence.

Kennedy said he was "neither for . . . nor against" a new inquiry. "Members of my family have been satisfied with it."

"If evidence develops to warrant the reopening of it, it should be reopened. If not, then it should not," he said.
