Announcer: KCBS news time 10:38 [a.m.] A Texas private investigating firm says it will release new evidence later this week which directly links the FBI with the assassination of President John Kennedy. A private firm known as Security Associates International claims to have uncovered irrefutable evidence that President Kennedy's assassination was engineered by what it called "the domestic intelligence arm of the FBI."

Security Associates says it's been investigating the JFK case for nearly two years. The company said it stepped up its probe at the request of a still-unidentified client. Security Associates bureau chief in Houston, David Salmon [phon] says that its client will also be identified publicly later this week. Salmon states that the firm's investigation has established "beyond a doubt" that the alleged conspiracy to assassinate President Kennedy was known in advance "at the highest levels of the FBI." Salmon says his company will release documents proving that both Lee Harvey Oswald and Jack Ruby were secretly working for the FBI prior to the assassination in Dallas.

Security Associates, which has offices in Dallas, Houston and Puerto Rico, consists almost entirely of ex-intelligence agents. Critics of its investigation are alleging that the firm may be attempting to protect other U.S. intelligence agencies by blaming JFK's murder solely on the FBI.
