In a speech reported over Havana radio yesterday ... Castro said about the Kennedy murder:

"Some imply that such action could have been retaliation by the Cuban revolution for the actions carried out against the lives of our leaders [in the early days of the Cuban revolution]. In truth, we reiterate that never has the Cuban revolution utilized terrorism.

"I can categorically affirm that the Cuban revolution never had the most minor participation in the death of the President of the United States, John Kennedy."
