Mysterious letter

Oswald Note To H. L. Hunt Is Reported

Lee Harvey Oswald allegedly sent a mysterious handwritten letter to the late Texas oil magnate H. L. Hunt two weeks before John F. Kennedy was killed in Dallas, the New York News reported last night.

The newspaper said that an unidentified federal investigator told it that the note was dated Nov. 8, 1963, and said:

"Dear Mr. Hunt,

"I would like information concerning my position. I am asking only for information. I am suggesting that we discuss the matter fully before any steps are taken by me or anyone else. Thank you."

The newspaper said the letter was signed "Lee Harvey Oswald."

The investigator, according to the News, said he compared samples of Oswald's handwriting with the note and concluded it was "written by Oswald or someone who was able to copy his writing style." The Warren Commission concluded that Oswald assassinated Kennedy.
