WASHINGTON, FEB. 1 (AP)-THE WARREN COMMISSION INVESTIGATING THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY SAID TODAY IT WILL TAKE TESTIMONY FROM MRS. MARINA OSWALD AT THE COMMISSION OFFICES IN WASHINGTON MONDAY.

A SPOKESMAN SAID THE WIDOW OF LEE OSWALD, WHO WAS ACCUSED OF KILL-ING KENNEDY AND THEN WAS IN TURN FATALLY SHOT HIMSELF, WILL APPEAR AT 10 A.M. EST.

OT NO "FURTHER DETAILS WERE DISCLOSED.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THE COMMISSION HAS NO INFORMATION AT THIS TIME ON MRS. OSWALD'S TRAVEL PLANS, WHETHER SHE WILL BE REPRESENTED BY AN ATTORNEY AT THE QUESTIONING OR WHETHER SHE MIGHT BE QUESTIONED MORE THAN ONCE.

SHE IS APPEARING VOLUNTARILY, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

THE COMMISSION ANNOUNCED JAN. 27 THAT MRS. OSWALD WOULD BE QUES-TIONED WITHIN TWO WEEKS BUT DID NOT SAY SPECIFICALLY WHEN OR WHERE.

KENNEDY WAS SHOT TO DEATH IN DALLAS, TEX. NOV. 22.

MRS. OSWALD IS LIVING IN THE DALLAS AREA.
