washington, March 23 (AP)- The Warren Commission said today it will resume hearings tomorrow (Tuesday) with four employees of the Texas School Book Depository building and a fifth person who was in the vicinity when the late President John F. Kennedy was assassinated.

Also scheduled for an appearance later this week is the stenographer who typed up notes for Lee Harvey Oswald for a book the accused assassin was writing about Russia.

First witness at tomorrow's hearing is Howard L. Brennan, who was a witness to the assassination.

He will be followed by James Earl Ray, Bonnie Ray Williams and Harold Norman, employees at the Texas School Book Depository building, and the building superintendent, Roy S. Truly.

Authorities have said Oswald killed the late President with rifle ~~fire~~ shots fired from a window in the building, where he was employed.
