washington, March 2 (AP)- The warren commission took testimony today from experts about the fingerprints of Lee Harvey swald on various articles.

Reporters asked Allen Dulles, a commission member, if the testimony concerned a rifle which police say was used in the assassination of President John. F. Kennedy last Nov. 22.

He replied it dealt with "the rifle and other articles found on the sixth floor of the Texas School Book Depository Building from which police say the shots were fired. Police also have said that Oswald's fingerprints were found on the rifle.

The commission took testimony from Sevastian atona, FBI expert on ktent fingerprints; and detective Arthur Mandella, fingerprint expert of the New York police, who accompanied by Lt. Joseph Monney, also of the New York police.
