Outside technical experts are being called in to double check FBI findings in the investigation of President Kennedy's slay-

The special presidential commission investigating the assassination decided on the move to avoid possible future claims that FBI findings might have been rigged or colored by self-interest, it was learned.

The experts are making independent evaluations of such bits of evidence as the bullets, shells and guns allegedly used in the slayings of Mr. Kennedy and Dallas Policeman J. D. Tippit last November 22.

One expert, Joseph Nicol, findings indicate that bullet Chief Justice Earl Warren, superintendent of the Illinois fragments found at the scene has declined to give any de-Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation, traveled to Philadelphia to use new police laboratory facilities there to make ballistics tests of bullet fragments and casings gathered at the scenes of the murders.

He said the well-equipped FBI facilities here could have been used but the commission wanted to avoid any suggestion that the FBI played a role in his independent eval-

Nichol has declined to detail his findings other than to say that they did not change the picture as it is now known.
