Warren Report On Assassination Due in June

Washington

The Warren Commission investigating the assassination of President Kennedy may make its report to President Johnson and the American people "some time in June," Counsel J. Lee Rankin said yesterday.

Rankin indicated to newsmen, however, that the commission's work could well take longer. He said his staff is working as fast as possible right now, and "there are only 24 hours in a day."
