Washington, April 23 (AP)- Three Secret Service men and an FBI agent testify today before the Warren Commission.

The group probing the assassination of President John F. Kennedy last Nov. 22 heard top Dallas police yesterday.

Commission member John J. McCloy said the testimony of the police covered all aspects of the case, including security arrangements made for the President's visit to Dallas.

Appearing yesterday were Dallas police chief Jesse Curry; homicide Capt. Will Fritz; Lt. Carl Day and Lt. T.L. Baker.

Scheduled to testify today were Lunda L. Shaneyfelt, FBI agent at Dallas; Forrest V. Sorrels, Secret Service agent at Dallas; and Winstxon G. Lawson and Robert Bouch, with the Secret Service in Washington
