Washington, May 1 (AP)-President John F. Kennedy's widow and three FBI agents who had some connectio with Lee Harvey Oswald before he was killed will give testimony to the commission investigating Kennedy's assassination.

This was anno need by the commission today, which said FBI agents John W. Fain, now retired, and John L. Quigley and James B. Hosty will testify next Tuesday morning.

Mrs. Kennedy, who was sitting in the car with her husband when he was shot last Nov. ww 22 in Dallas, was told she could testify in person of give a deposition. A commission spokesman, saying the form would be announced later, told reporters Mrs. Kennedy has indicated she is willing to cooperate.

Gov. and Mrs. John Connally of Texas, who were in the car with the Kennedy's, testified last week.

The commisson also expects to call Mrs. Marina Oswald before it finishes thexa its job, probably next month. Mrs. Oswald's slain husband is accused of firing the shots that killed Kennedy, Oswald was shot to death two days later. Mrs. Oswald testified once before in the inquiry.
