Washington, May 12 (AP)- The heads of the FBI and the Central Intelligence Agency will be heard Thursday by the special presidential commission investigating the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

The commission announced today that FBI director J. Edgar Hoover will appear Thursday morning, and will be followed by CIA director John A. McCone.

The commission will hear testimony tomorrow from two officers from the Dallas Police Department's criminal intelligence division.

They are Lt. Jack Revill, superintendent of the division, and detective V.J. Brian. The commission did not go into further detail about the nature of their expected testimony.
