Dallas, May 27 (AP) - A re-enactment has established that bullets killing President Kennedy and wounding Texas Gov. John Connally could have been fired only from the Texas School Book Depository building, the Times Herald reported today.

About 25 FBI agents directed by J. Lee Rankin, chief counsel for the Warren Commission, spent nearly six hours Sunday in a detailed reconstruction of the Nov. 22 assassination.

Attributing its information to reliable sources, the Times Herald said the sole purpose was to settle without question the source of the bullets.

Investigators accused Lee Harvey Oswald, who was slain two days later by Dallas night club operator Jack Ruby, of firing the shots from a sixth floor window of the Depository building as Kennedy and Connally rode past.

In addition to taking movies from <sup>the</sup> window, the Times Herald said FBI agents filmed similar angle shots from a grassy embankment just west of the building in downtown Dallas and from an adjacent triple underpass.

The Dallas newspaper reported these further details:

In the opinion of investigators, it would have been impossible for any one of the three bullets - the two that hit Kennedy or the one that struck the Governor - to have been fired from either of these points.

Two FBI agents played the roles of the late President and Connally and a special secret service car was flown from Washington for the reenactment.

Surveyors were on the scene to measure certain angles from the sixth floor corner window to the street below, where the bullets hit their targets.

Looking through the gunsight of the rifle used by the assassin and exact measurement of the angle from the window, plus the results of the official autopsies<sup>?</sup> and medical reports, leave no doubt the bullets were fired from the depository building.

The Warren Commission's desire to decide this issue with such detail was prompted by recurring rumors that the bullets came from other directions.

DALLAS, MAY 27 (AP)—A RE-ENACTMENT HAS ESTABLISHED THAT BULLETS KILLING PRESIDENT KENNEDY AND WOUNDING TEXAS GOV. JOHN CONNALLY COULD HAVE BEEN FIRED ONLY FROM THE TEXAS SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY BUILDING, THE TIMES HERALD REPORTED TODAY.

ABOUT 25 FBI AGENTS DIRECTED BY J. LEE RANKIN, CHIEF COUNSEL FOR THE WARREN COMMISSION, SPENT NEARLY SIX HOURS SUNDAY IN A DETAILED REENACTMENT OF THE NOV. 22 ASSASSINATION.

ATTRIBUTING ITS INFORMATION TO RELIABLE SOURCES, THE TIMES HERALD SAID THE SOLE PURPOSE WAS TO SETTLE WITHOUT QUESTION THE SOURCE OF THE BULLETS.

INVESTIGATORS ACCUSED LEE HARVEY OSWALD, WHO WAS SLAIN TWO DAYS LATER BY DALLAS NIGHT CLUB OPERATOR JACK RUBY, OF FIRING THE SHOTS FROM A SIXTH FLOOR WINDOW OF THE DEPOSITORY BUILDING AS KENNEDY AND CONNALLY DROVE PAST.

IN ADDITION TO TAKING MOVIES FROM THIS WINDOW, THE TIMES HERALD SAID FBI AGENTS FILMED SEVERAL ANGLES FROM A GRASSY EMMENT JUST WEST OF THE BUILDING IN DOWNTOWN DALLAS AND FROM AN ADJACENT TRIPLE OVERPASS.

THE DALLAS NEWSPAPER REPORTED THESE FURTHER DETAILS:

IN THE OPINION OF INVESTIGATORS, IT WOULD HAVE BEEN IMPOSSIBLE FOR ANY ONE OF THE THREE BULLETS--THE TWO THAT HIT KENNEDY OR THE ONE THAT STRUCK THE GOVERNOR--TO HAVE BEEN FIRED FROM EITHER OF THESE POINTS.

TWO FBI AGENTS PLAYED THE OLES OF THE LATE PRESIDENT AND  
CONNALLY AND A SPECIAL SECRET SERVICE CAR WAS FLOWN FROM WASHINGTON  
FOR THE REENACTMENT.

SURVEYORS WERE ON THE SCENE TO MEASURE CERTAIN ANGLES FROM THE  
SIXTH FLOOR CORNER WINDOW TO THE STREET BELOW, WHERE THE BULLETS  
HIT THEIR TARGETS.

LOOKING THROUGH THE GUNSIGHT OF THE RIFLE USED BY THE ASSASSIN  
AND EXACT MEASUREMENT OF THE ANGLE FROM THE WINDOW, PLUS THE  
RESULTS OF THE OFFICIAL AUTOPSIES AND MEDICAL REPORTS, LEAVE NO  
DOUBT THE BULLETS WERE FIRED FROM THE DEPOSITORY BUILDING.

THE WARREN COMMISSION'S DESIRE TO DECIDE THIS ISSUE WITH SUCH DETAIL  
WAS PROMPTED BY RECURRING RUMORS THAT THE BULLETS CAME FROM OTHER  
DIRECTIONS.
