WX LOCALS OUT

(200) ASSASSINATION REPORT

WASHINGTON, AUG. 3 (AP)-THE EVENING STAR SAID TODAY THE WARREN COMMISSION WILL DEVOTE MUCH OF ITS FORTHCOMING REPORT TO REBUTTING SPECULATION THAT THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY RESULTED FROM A DOMESTIC OR INTERNATIONAL CONSPIRACY.

THE REPORT OF THE SEVEN-MEMBER COMMISSION HEADED BY CHIEF JUSTICE EARL WARREN IS EXPECTED TO BE MADE PUBLIC SEPT. 14, ALTHOUGH IT WILL BE PRESENTED TO PRESIDENT JOHNSON A WEEK OR TWO EARLIER, THE STAR SAID.

THE STORY SAID DETAILED REBUTTALS TO THE CONSPIRACY SPECULATION WILL APPEAR IN TWO SECTIONS OF THE REPORT.

THE STAR SAID THE COMMISSION IS AWARE OF DOUBTS, ESPECIALLY IN EUROPE, THAT A LONE ASSASSIN WAS SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SHOOTING OF KENNEDY IN DALLAS, TEX., LAST NOV. 22.

THE COMMISSION WILL GIVE AN "ANALYTICAL CONSIDERATION" OF ALL ELEMENTS OF THE ASSASSINATION AND THE SUBSEQUENT SLAYING OF ACCUSED ASSASSIN LEE HARVEY OSWALD BY NIGHT CLUB FIGURE JACK RUBY, THE STAR SAID.

IT SAID THE BULKY REPORT NOW RUNS TO 660 PAGES, PLUS 18 VOLUMES OF TRANSCRIPTS OF TESTIMONY AND DEPOSITIONS FROM WITNESSES.

THE REPORT WILL ANALYZE SPECULATION ABOUT BOTH THE POSSIBILITY OF A RIGHT WING CONSPIRACY WITHIN THE UNITED STATES OR AN INTERNATIONAL-IST LEFT WING CONSPIRACY, THE STAR SAID.

THE COMMISSION, IT ADDED, IS NOW GOING OVER DRAFTS OF EVERY CHAPTER OF THE REPORT TO MAKE SURE ALL CONCLUSIONS ARE FULLY DOCUMENTED AND ALL QUESTIONS FULLY ANSWERED.
