

# And Now We Switch to Dallas'

TELEVISION'S next big news story will be the Warren Commission report on the assassination of President Kennedy, which is expected next month.

At that time the networks will be ready with full-scale treatments and documentaries of the event that shook the world less than a year ago. All three are prepared to produce a report on the commission's findings the day after it is made public despite the fact that it runs to 50 pages, plus seven volumes of testimony and 60 pages of documents.

In addition both NBC and CBS have been preparing documentaries on the assassination for showing early next year. One of these is an "NBC White Paper." CBS has interviewed practically every major witness to the tragedy and has been working on its program since May.
