Briefing on The Warren Report

Washington

The Warren Commission report on the assassination of President John F. Kennedy will be released for use by newspapers, television, radio and other media at 6:30 p. m. (EDT) Sunday, the White House announced yesterday.

Press Secretary George Reedy announced the release hour at a briefing attended by about 150 newsmen. Reedy declined to permit publication in advance of the manner in which the report will be released for publication, its size, the methods of distribution and other similar

information.

Chief Justice Earl Warren and the six other members of the presidential investigating commission created nearly ten months ago are scheduled to present the massive

report—known to be more than 700 pages long—to President Johnson at the White House tomorrow morning.

The report will go on sale at the Government Printing Office Monday morning, im-

mediately after publication of its contents in Monday morning newspapers.

Hardbound copies will sell for \$3.25 and paperback copies at \$2.50 each.
