

# Rockefeller Said to Check Report Of CIA on Kennedy Assassination

William Lee Harvey Oswald  
 Mr. Hunt, who is presently  
 return to prison following  
 a reversal of an appeal seeking  
 to overturn his conviction, re-  
 portedly testified in a closed  
 session with Rockefeller com-  
 mission investigators on wed-  
 nesday.

Mr. Gregory met with com-  
 mission investigators earlier,

Mr. Hunt reportedly told the  
 commission staff that he was  
 at home in the Washington,

 1963, less than two months be-  
 fore the Kennedy assassination,  
 when he requested permission  
 to visit Cuba from the Castro  
 Government's embassy there.
