

CIA Panel May Probe JFK Killing

San Diego, April 3 - President Ford said today that the Rockefeller commission may investigate a report that the [CIA] was involved in the 1963 assassination of President Kennedy.

At the same time the President used apparently carefully chosen language to defend the basic conclusion of the Warren commission which investigated the slaying....

The question came as a surprise at a news conference which largely focused on Vietnam issues. So did Mr. Ford's apparent preparation for it and his careful answer.

White House press secretary Ron Nessen said afterward that Mr. Ford was able to answer the question with such precision because the President had looked up the Warren commission findings "within the past month."

Nessen said the subject was being discussed about the time the allegations were raised about possible CIA involvement
