

Warren Commission recommendations (Report, p. 454 to 467)

Legislation to make a Federal crime
murder or manslaughter of, attempt or conspiracy to murder,
kidnapping of and assault upon the President, Vice President,
or other officer next in the order of succession,
President-elect or Vice-President-elect.

Committee of Cabinet officers
with responsibility to review and oversee protective
activities of Secret Service and other Federal agencies that
assist in safeguarding the President.

Responsibilities for Presidential protection:
better coordination and direction of activities of all
existing agencies which are in a position to furnish
information and services related to the security of the
President (Secret Service, FBI, State Department, CIA).

Secret Service:
general supervision - daily supervision of its operations
should be improved; Secretary of the Treasury should appoint
special assistant with responsibility of supervising
Secret Service,

preventive intelligence - broader and more selective
criteria; liaison with other agencies regarding
intelligence; automatic data processing; Protective
Research participation in advance arrangements,

liaison with local law enforcement agencies,

inspection of buildings,

increase in personnel and facilities,

manpower and technical assistance from other agencies.
