

**LONGER GUARDVOTED
FOR MRS. KENNEDY**

WASHINGTON, Aug. 16 (AP) — The Senate Judiciary Committee approved today a bill providing for Secret Service protection for two more years for Mrs. John F. Kennedy and her two young children.

The measure, requested by the Treasury Department, also provides lifetime Secret Service protection for former Presidents, unless this is declined.

This would apply now to former Presidents Dwight D. Eisenhower and Harry S. Truman.

After the assassination of President Kennedy on Nov. 22, 1963, Congress passed a bill to provide Secret Service protection for Mrs. Kennedy and her children, Caroline and John, for two years.

Protection under that measure will end Dec. 11 of this year. The bill approved by the committee today would extend this for two years.
