Washington, Sept. 17 (AP)- Mrs. John F. Kennedy and her children will have Secret Service protection for another two years under a bill signed yesterday by President Johnson.

The new law provides a lifetime Secret Service guard for former presidents and four years of such protection for the widow and minor children of any president who dies in office.

A special law passed after the death of President John F. Kennedy authorized a two-year guard over his widow and children. Former presidents heretofore have been guarded for no longer than six months.
