WASHINGTON, NOV. 24 (AP)-IN HIS OWN VERSION OF AN IDEAL SOCIETY, LEE HARVEY OSWALD OPPOSED THE SALE OF RIFLES, EXCEPT WITH POLICE PERMISSION.

OSWALD ASSASSINATED THE LATE PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY IN DALLAS, TEX., NOV. 22, 1963, WITH A RIFLE HE HAD PURCHASED FROM A MAIL ORDER HOUSE.

BUT IN A BRIEF OUTLINE OSWALD HAD WRITTEN ABOUT HIS VIEWS OF AN IDEAL SOCIETY, RELEASED AMONG OTHER EXHIBITS BY THE WARREN COMMISSION, OSWALD SAID:

"PISTOLS SHOULD NOT BE SOLD IN ANY CASE, RIFLES ONLY WITH POLICE PERMISSION, SHOTGUNS FREE."

OSWALD LABELED HIS IDEAL SOCIETY AS "THE ATHEIAN (SIC) SYSTEM" AND DESCRIBED IT AS "A SYSTEM OPPOSED TO COMMUNISM, SOCIALISM AND CAPITALISM."
