

**STAFF WORK DELAYS
WARREN DOCUMENTS**

WASHINGTON, Oct. 6 (UPI) —Attempts by the Warren Commission staff to perfect footnotes is delaying publication of testimony given before the commission.

Sources close to the commission said there were no mechanical problems left to prevent publishing the volumes that contain documentation for the report made public by the commission last week.

But it still could take more than a month to complete work on all the expected 18 volumes, they said.

Staff members are insisting that all volumes include exten-

sive footnotes and references, so the reader can find related material elsewhere in the testimony, the sources said.
