Volume Sales

During the three weeks that the record of the Warren Commission hearings on the assassination of President Kennedy has been on sale, more than one-third of the sets containing verbatim testimony have been purchased.

The Government Printing Office, which published the books, will have exhausted its stock in another month if the current demand continues. Each set of 26 volumes costs \$76.

The office printed 2,500 sets. As of last Friday, 846 had been sold.
