HERE IN BRIEF ARE THE MAJOR FINDINGS OF THE WARREN COMMISSION IN ITS REPORT ON THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY:

LEE HARVEY OSWALD AND JACK RUBY ACTED AS LONERS--THEY DID NOT KNOW EACH OTHER; THERE WAS NO CONSPIRACY--AT HOME OR FROM ABROAD.

VARYING AMOUNTS OF CRITICISM ARE AIMED AT THE SECRET SERVICE, THE FBI, DALLAS POLICE, THE NEWS MEDIA AND THE STATE DEPARTMENT.

A CABINET COMMITTEE SHOULD ASSUME TOP RESPONSIBILITY FOR PRESIDENTIAL PROTECTION.

A DRASTIC UPDATING IS NEEDED IN METHODS FOR PROTECTING PRESIDENTS.

MURDER OF A PRESIDENT OR VICE PRESIDENT SHOULD BE MADE A FEDERAL CRIME.
