8 REPORT-ADDITIONS

WASHINGTON, SEPT. 28 (AP)-WHITE HOUSE OFFICIALS SAY THE REMAINDER OF THE WARREN COMMISSION REPORT ON PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S ASSASSINATION-- SOME 20 VOLUMES--WILL BE MADE PUBLIC AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. BUT THEY HAVE SET NO DATE.

THE VOLUMES INCLUDED TESTIMONY GIVEN TO THE COMMISSION AS WELL AS PICTURES OF EXHIBITS GATHERED BY THE COMMISSION. ORIGINALLY IT HAD BEEN PLANNED TO RELEASE THESE VOLUMES WITH THE COMMISSION'S 296,000-WORD REPORT. A WHITE HOUSE OFFICIAL SAID PLANS WERE CHANGED IN ORDER TO CONCENTRATE ON PRINTING AND DISTRIBUTION OF 50,000 COPIES OF THE COMMISSION'S FINDINGS.
