WARREN REPORT-FOREIGN POLICY

WASHINGTON, SEPT. 28 (AP)-THE WARREN COMMISSION'S CONCLUSION THAT THE KENNEDY ASSASSINATION WAS THE WORK OF ONE MAN ALONE, WITHOUT FOREIGN OR DOMESTIC CONSPIRACY, WAS EXPECTED AND WELCOMED BY U.S. FOREIGN POLICYMAKERS.

ANY OFFICIAL FINDING THAT LINKED THE KILLING OF THE PRESIDENT TO A FOREIGN POWER COULD HAVE POSED THE GRAVEST QUESTIONS INVOLVING U.S. RELATIONS WITH THE ACCUSED NATION.

AS IT WAS, THE COMMISSION STRESSED THE CONTRARY AND IN SO DOING WAS IN HARMONY WITH THE VIEWS OF SECRETARY OF STATE DEAN RUSK.

RUSK TESTIFIED HE HAD NO SCRAP OF EVIDENCE INDICATING THE SOVIETS EITHER WANTED THE ASSASSINATION OR TOOK PART IN IT, THE COMMISSION'S REPORT DISCLOSED.

AS FOR COMMUNIST CUBA, ALSO ABSOLVED BY THE COMMISSION, RUSK SAID THAT AFTER THE TRAGEDY THE HAVANA REGIME FEARED IT MIGHT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE AND WAS CONCERNED ABOUT THE POSSIBLE CONSEQUENCES TO ITS OWN SAFETY.

THE U.S. INFORMATION AGENCY WAS GIVING THE REPORT SPEEDY GLOBAL DISTRIBUTION WITH HOPES OF SQUASHING SOME OF THE WIDESPREAD FOREIGN GOS- SIP ABOUT THE ASSASSINATION. PRIVATELY, OFFICIALS ANTICIPATED THAT SOME UNFOUNDED RUMORS WOULD CONTINUE TO CIRCULATE OR NEW ONES WOULD SPRING UP DESPITE THE COMMISSION'S DETAILED EFFORT TO SCOTCH THEM.

ALTHOUGH THE MAN NAMED AS THE ASSASSIN, LEE HARVEY OSWALD, WAS AN AVOWED MARXIST, LEFTIST CIRCLES ABROAD HAVE PORTRAYED THE KILLING AS A RIGHTIST PLOT.

ONE VERSION IS THAT OSWALD WAS USED AS A TOOL, THEN SILENCED BY THE GUN OF NIGHTCLUB OPERATOR JACK RUBY.
