He lived in Minsk (Russia), which is where Marina Oswald lived and also where Oswald worked during his stay in Russia; in the Minsk radio factory. They then moved to Poland in 1929, lived there for quite some time.

He testified for 118 pages of the Warren Commission in 1964 (in volume 9). He secured a job for Oswald as a ~~the~~ photographer in a highly specialized government security position ~~the~~ which involved highly specialized photography such as micro-dotting, a firm by the name of Jagger-Chiles-Stovall. He came to the U.S. in 1938, securing a high placed ~~position~~ position ~~at~~ at Humble Oil in 1939 in ~~Houston~~ Houston, Texas. He produced documentaries for a movie company. He then went to work ^{ostensibly} in a sugar factory in Mexico. He was suspected at this time of drawing installations for the military, whereupon he came back to Texas in 1944, working for various oil companies, including Pantopak Oil Company as a field engineer. In 1945 he worked under Warren Smith, ^{with} president of Pantopak, ~~to~~ who, along with De Morenschildt, formed the Cuban-Venezuelian Oil Trust Company in Cuba where they owned half of the entire country under oil leases, and when Castro took over, they lost this ~~extra~~ highly lucrative enterprise, giving them added reason to hate ~~Castro~~, and make war against Castro. He ~~soon~~ afterwards became assistant president of the American Petroleum Institute. He was shot to death with a 20 gauge shotgun (in the mouth).

He was Oswald's most frequent companion on his return to Dallas from Russia in 1962. During World War 2, he had worked for French intelligence ^(also collaborating with the Nazis in order to destroy Soviet power). During the Bay of Pigs in 1961, he was in Guatemala ^(under the CIA training camps for Castro's exiles who fled). At the time of the JFK assassination, he was in Haiti. He was a member of the exclusive Dallas Petroleum Club and had many high-level contacts in the business world. De Mohrenschildt stated that he was unable to remember exactly how he first met Oswald, but it was his recollection that he went to Oswald's residence in the Fort Worth slums, before Oswald moved to Dallas, that he visited Oswald there with a certain Colonel Orlov. Isn't it rather curious that this so called near-do-well, Oswald, attracted

visitations from such high powered personalities?

De Mohrenschildt introduced Oswald to Ruth Paine, the woman who was instrumental in obtaining the job for Oswald at the Book Depository. She called Roy Truly, the manager, and recommended that Truly hire him there. Incidentally, the income tax records of Ruth Paine remain classified by the government to this day.
