We have now been working on the assassination of President John F. Kennedy for more than five years, and we feel it is time for a report. We have been accused of going into the case for the publicity and for the money we have made. This charge is not true.

We feel lucky that we live near Dallas for we felt absolutely compelled to work on this case and we feel lucky that we have only lost \$13,000 during this time. We are grateful that we had the money to spend.
