CORRECTION

A reprint of an editorial in the Abington, Clark Summit, Pa. Journal reminds us to urge a correction. The editorial alleges that J. Edgar Hoover blackmailed Rev. Martin Luther King. We urge the paper to use the words "attempted to blackmail" the Rev. Dr. King, holder of the Nobel

Peace Prize.
