

SEEK TO KEEP MEMORY ALIVE

Urge Kennedy Corps Name

A group of Milwaukeeans was circulating petitions Sunday designed to have the name of the peace corps changed to Kennedy corps in honor of the late President John F. Kennedy, who strongly supported organization of the corps.

Admittedly organized loosely

and hastily, the group hopes to have the campaign taken up on a nation-wide scale by other interested parties, according to John Russ, 25, of 2935 N. Prospect av.

Present plans are to send the petitions to President Johnson,

unless a more formal procedure is necessary to get congressional action, Russ said. The petition states:

"The following signees petition the solemn government of the United States of America to change the name of the

peace corps to the name of the Kennedy corps to commemorate the death of a statesman whose visionary leadership can be traced back to the intellects of Washington, Jefferson and Adams."

Milwaukee legislators, in a spontaneous, bipartisan demonstration Sunday, forgot their political differences and pledged \$100 to the Wisconsin Council for Retarded Children in memory of the late President John F. Kennedy.
