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The shirt that Kennedy was wearing at the time of his assassination was examined by the FBI laboratory. They stated that there were two small slit-like holes below the collar button, no bullet metal was found in the fabric, and a small elongated nick was also found in the left side of the front of the tie, possibly caused by a projectile. Hoover's statement of the shirt also included that the torn threads around the hole were bent outward, which are characteristic of an exit hole. The FBI report did not state this fact. There were many examinations of the shirt that the fibers were moved many times and can not be used as evidence. If the nick on the tie was caused by a projectile, the tie would have to be placed in an unfavorable place. There was no examination on the tie due to the characteristics of the nick.
