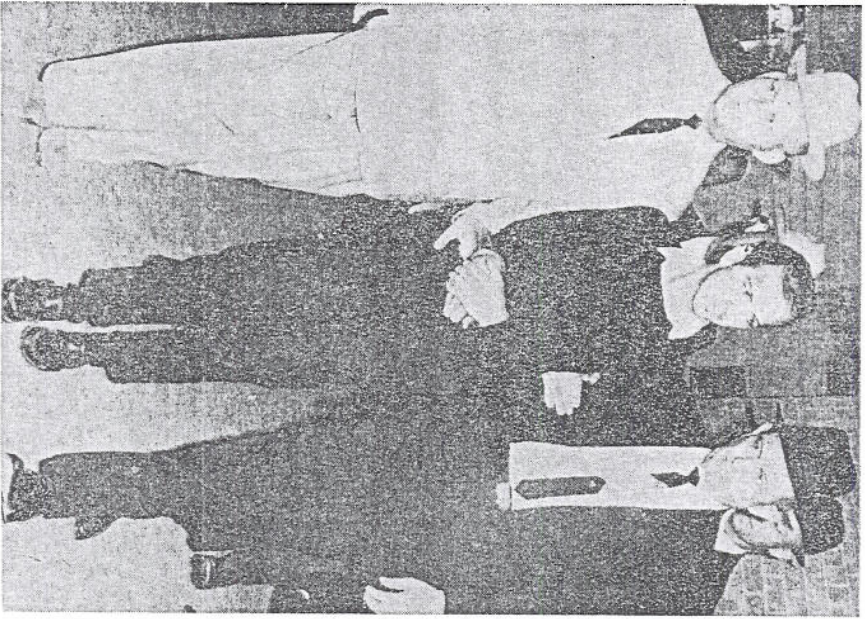

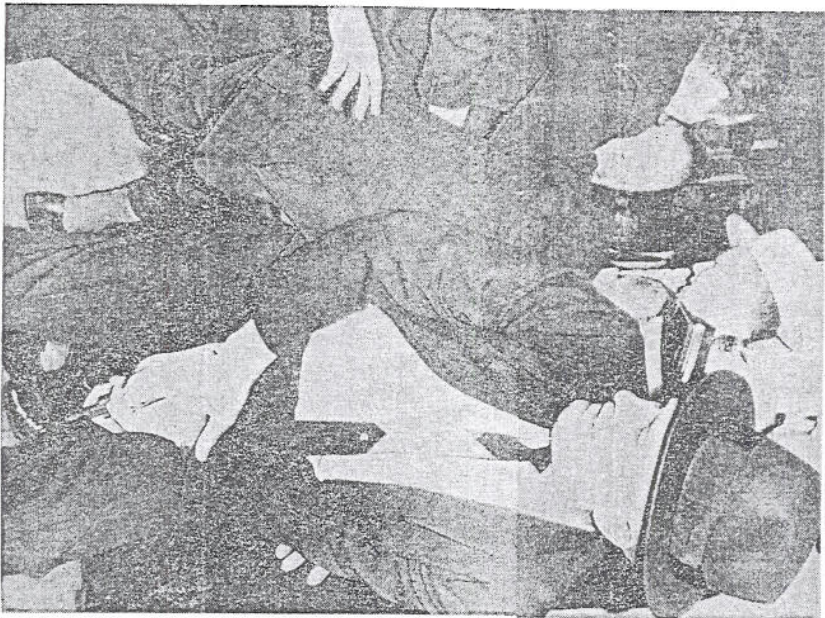
Lee H. Oswald, Escorted Toward Armored Police Car

A Look of Anguish Comes to Oswald, Right, After Being Hit by Single Shot



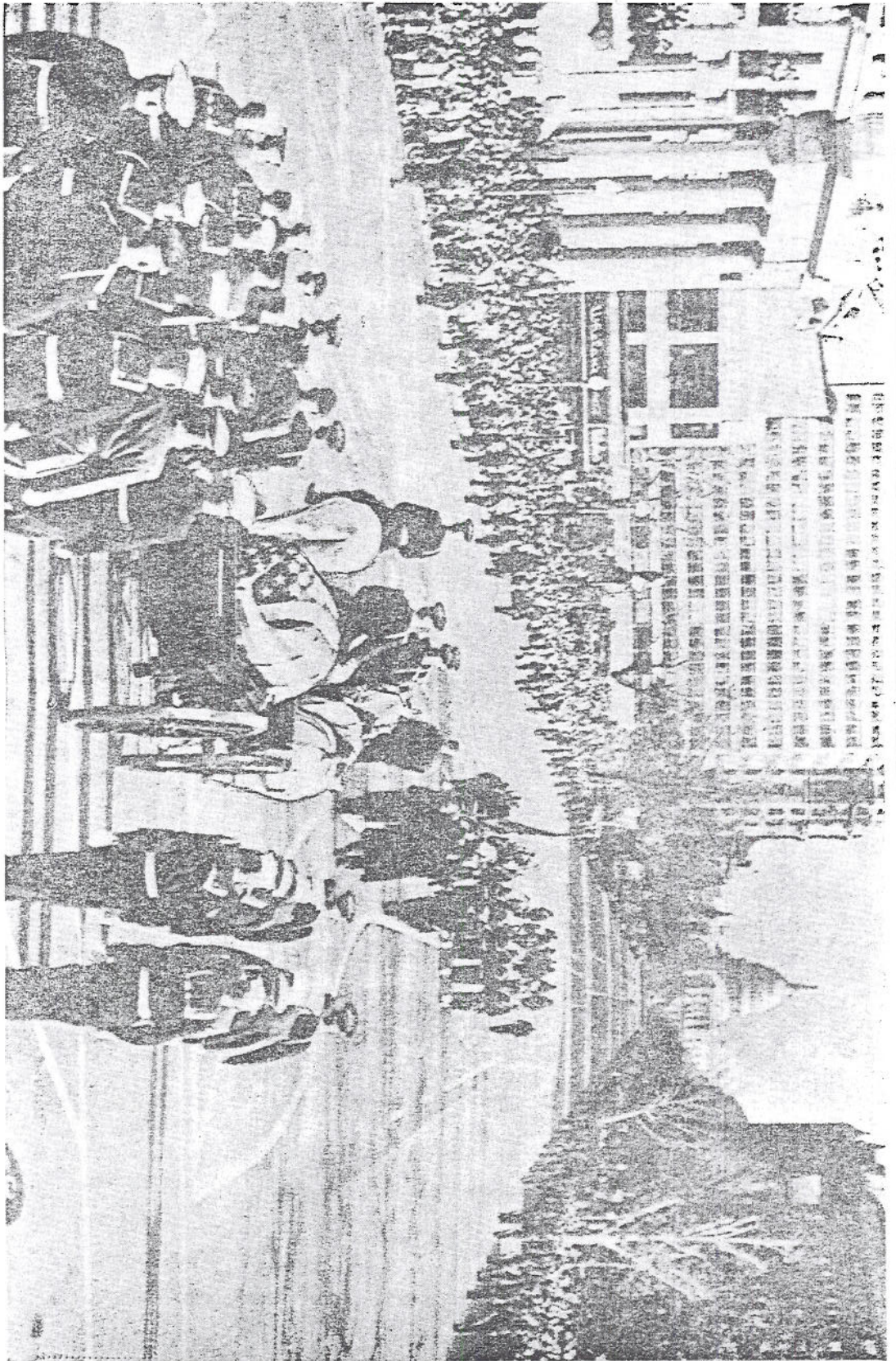
Police Grapple for Gun With Ruby in Jail Basement



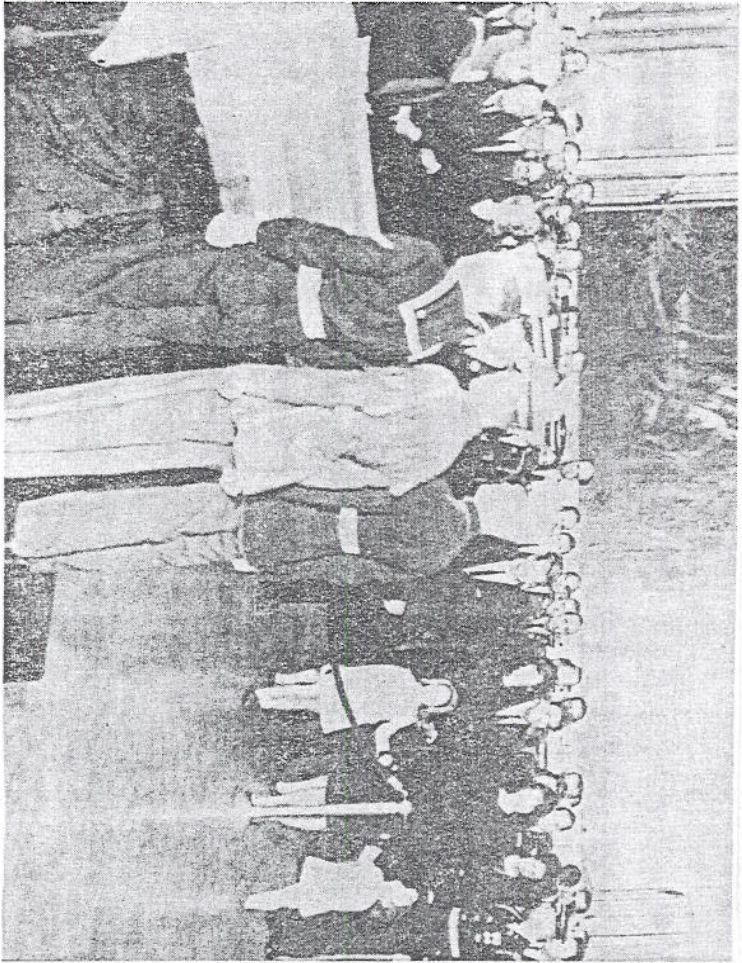
Mrs. Jacqueline Kennedy stood at the White House entrance with her children, John, Jr., and Caroline, before joining the procession in which her husband's

body was borne from the executive mansion to the capitol. At the left were Atty. Gen. Robert Kennedy and Mrs. Jean Smith, sister of the slain president.

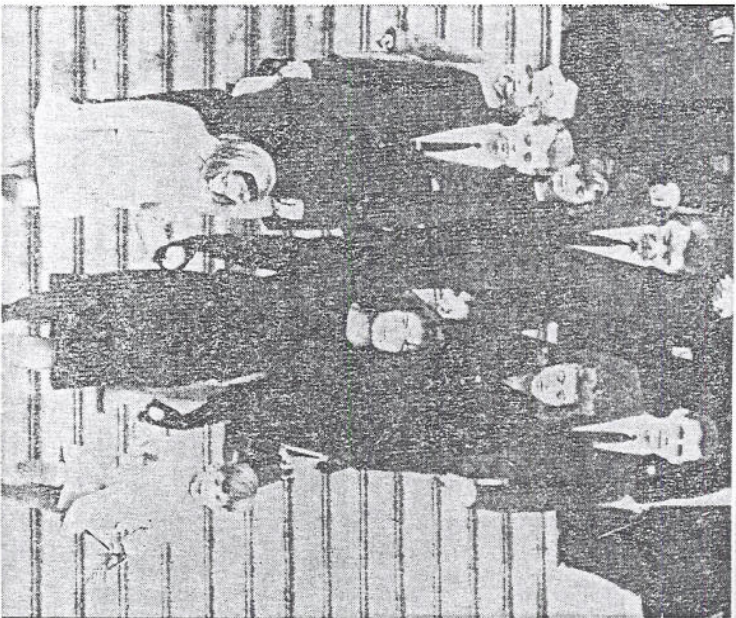

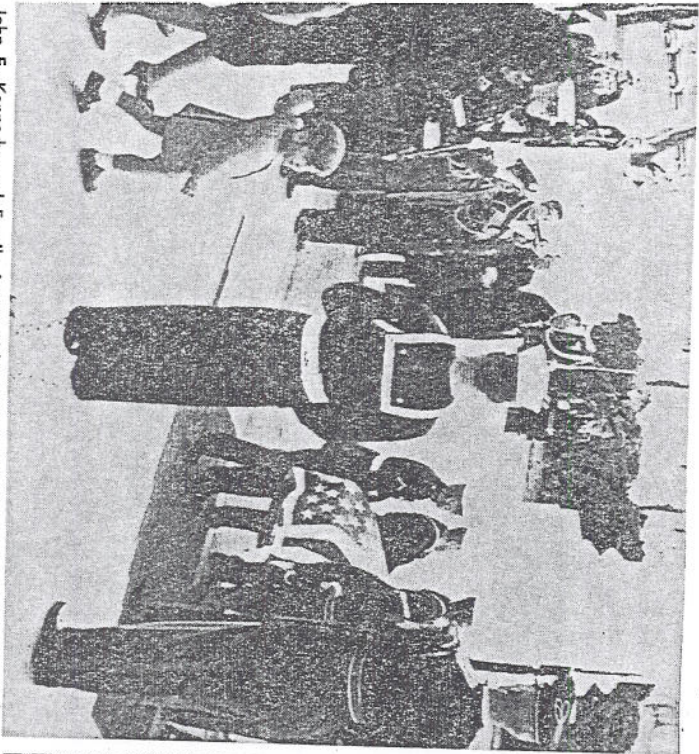

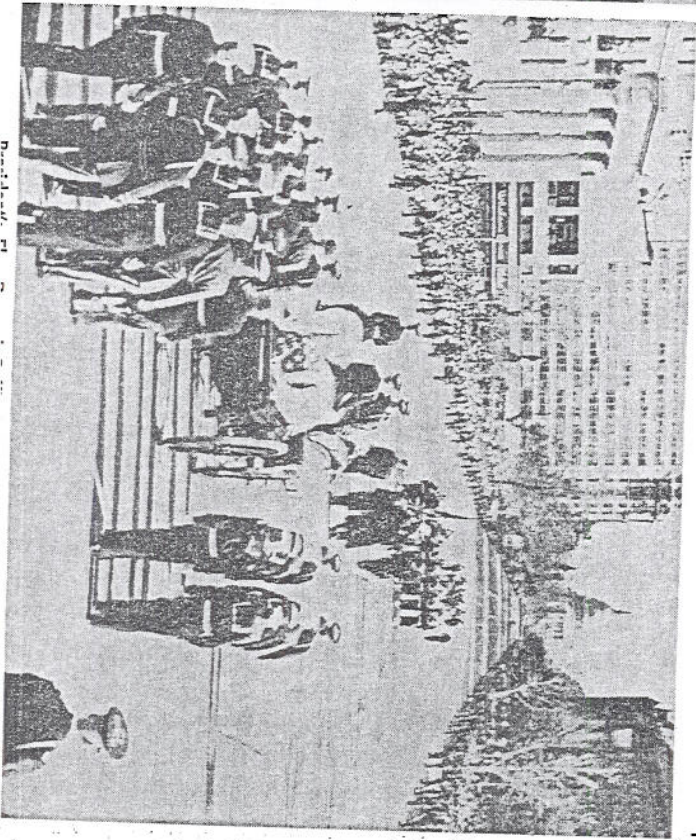
