

Grandmother Not Yet Told News

BOSTON (UPI) — Mrs. John A. Fitzgerald, President Kennedy's grandmother, 98, remained unaware Saturday night that her famous grandson was dead.

Her son, Thomas A. Fitzgerald, left for Washington with his family to attend the President's funeral. "Grammie" remained behind in the care of two nurses.

Her son said earlier Saturday that he planned to tell her the tragic news, "but I don't know when." A nurse said Saturday night that Mrs. Fitzgerald might be informed of the assassination after her son's return from Washington.

Mrs. Fitzgerald is confined to the second floor of her home.
