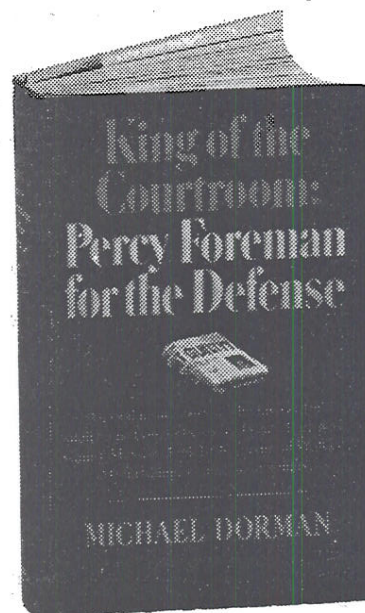
Perhaps, when you read F-U, you'll understand some of the basis for this hunch. I now have more reason for this interest.
