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Dear Js, If you do not get the full Graham story, I'll probably get it from Howard. Ian offered to buy me a copy when he phoned, but he was alone in the office today and had copy to file and if he gets it xeroxed in the National Press Bldg it costs 25¢ a page. He can't take time to paste it on a sheet, so that would have cost more than the costly paper. However, he is keeping the piece, so I can and will get it from him if not from another source. ... If you want amplification of what I have not gone into, let me know. Only the baby in all of this, Howard, acts and thinks like a man, so I have to regard the others as babies and not trust them. For example, and I'm presuming you will have seen something from the Times wire service, regardless of who took possession from Evelyn Lincoln, it was for the Kennedy library. That is under the Archives. Johnson only told Graham that it was not in the Archives Building. My source is good enough, Tom Kelly. Nor is it recent. I've known this for years. Regardless of the use of Burkley's name, the transfer was by the

Secret Service. Same source and it is not the only one on this. The S.S. got everything immediately, where there is a record. There is none of the brain and tissue, etc., because that remained at Bethesda until after completion of the so-called tests. There is a supplementary autopsy report. Neither Cyril nor his "experts" understood it. And today the brain and these samples are a monster diversion. We, or at least I, am far past that. Several years ago George Herman of CBS had an inquiry about the brain. I then helped him in his effort to locate it but don't recall the end. ... There was no tissue taken from the anterior neck, so there can be no sample. At this point it makes little difference if the sample from the rear non-fatal is produced, for it will show scorching and will be taken as further validation of the Report and all official fiction... Some areas of doubt and question remain, but there is none about the anterior neck wound... In the strange way in which anxiety works and doesn't work and I can't understand, none of this or any of the writing I've done has made me anxious, as I would have expected. I guess it is because there is little surprise in it. H
