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3/4-My interest in Kleindienst has been in FOI only, then I added a few things reflecting his repressive beliefs. In the current hearings, anything that you do not want bearing on his attitudes and records in these things could be of interest, but not immediate interest. So, if you see anything, don't make a special mailing of it. Harrisburg case, my chief interest is in the informant and his relations with and help and direction from the government, in a context you know. Little news, nothing from anyone, no call from Graham, etc. One thing is over-clear now: if the "liberal" Democratic leadership hadn't copped out in advance, the Kleindienst confirmation could have been a significant thing and I doubt he'd have been confirmed. They could have used it as a vehicle for sharpening and informing on issues, but they were a) unprincipled, b) cowardly, and c) overwhelmed by China, which they do not yet understand. They have, as of now, quit on that, too, whereas they could have taken the play pretty much away from Nixon with imagination and if they know enough to hold the positions they do-or if they use their staffs for much more than wardheeling issues. Sad commentary on times and prospects when hopes were first in the likes of them. Best, HW
