Ben Smith told Ian McDonald he is trying to get local black lawyers interested in doing something....CBS TV 7 a.m. news had long interview with 5 black students, including leader, Prejean, rather effective in letting them state basic issues. An electrical engineering major illustrated by saying that instead of staying in classrooms talking about circuits they should spend some time in the black community tending to its electrical needs. They were more clear than others in the past in articulating black-culture desires, Prejean illustrating by citing appropriation to white college at Lafayette for study, perpetuation "culture of the Acadian people". White intending it, they will have illuminated to the perceptive white the deficiencies of black education in La. below college level. They had their ideas clearly enough in mind but had poor command of the language. HW
