

Should you find a few idle moments, would you take a new look at Tad Szulc's 6/21/72 ^{DEC 7 1973} NYT piece headed "Ex-GOP Aide Rebuffs" and then, in the light of what it was later learned that Szulc knew about Hunt and didn't report in this piece, offer opinions on whether that would have been enough for the NYTimes to do something about Szulc and if you agree that what Szulc suppressed suggests that as of the time he wrote the piece he had a continuing CIA relationship of some kind?
