While there is much in this wide-ranging little item that anyone would question, especially in the last segment, I believe it may develop into something and that you may sometime find it useful.

The discussion of Cy Hersch particularly is interesting and up to a point fits ideas I have entertained about him since he broke the Cally story, which he hardly could have done without some very influential help.

The last bit particularly is almost pure paranoia, but may provide some food for thought and insights into future developments. If Howard should have the NY Times for Sunday, Jan. 20, you might like to suggest that he excerpt the Hersch piece if he still has it around.

The first part of the excerpt, on the UCLA violence center, is not exaggerated. It has been well-aired here for many months and this treatment is standard for its critics.
