JDW: I'm pushing so hard I'm getting more forgetful. I've been at it several hours and day is not yet breaking. But I find these early hours the most productive, even when I'm tired. They are not interrupted. I've just reorganized the second section of the add to Post Mortem, While doing it I decided to include some of the new material not related to the autopsy. Two things I'm forgotten are to tell that that as of 8/16 our route number is changing to 12 instead of 8/2 and to ask your opinion of a news subtitle from Post Mortem: JFK Assassination Secrets. While most of it is on the autopsy and relates, I'll be adding much more in ballistics, some of which is in earlier parts. I also have more on the framing of the Kennedys. More of FOIA, judges, DJ, FBI, CIA. (I hope you don't find the brief mention of Nosenko a wrench. I use it in illustrating how nuts in doing Dept. Disinfo jobs do not do what they could and how this helps the agencies. Of course the essence of the Nosenko story is vital in understanding the deliberateness of the official faking and the suppressions this required.
