

Note attached to Hersh's 7/10/75, "Detective Says Scientist Had Severe Psychosis" notes name Dr. Harold Alexander Abrahamson seems familiar. Did to me, too. My only file is on David Abrahamson, supposed shrink expert on assassins, etc, dating to 1967. However, I think I recall a Today Show appearance. Phone inquiry to NBC immediately brought no response.

After reading the clips you sent I feel even more than with the apparent attention the media is giving this story it really is not covering it, really is not following leads. I have no knowledge but it appears to me that it is reacting to what those involved in the past or volunteering in the present. The possibility of getting beat on feeds if not followed may account for those stories getting used. No effort, for example, to check scientific indexes, writings, contracts (often hidden in other agencies' appropriations), etc.
